Team France sports Berluti for opening ceremony of Paralympic Games

and red shades with a gradient effect, mirroring the smoky look of patinated leather, the sartorial detail harkening back to the luxury maison's roots.

In light of the International Paralympic Committee production, Berluti offered women a choice of trousers or a skirt, matched respectively with the brand's Shadow sneaker or Lorenzo loafer, while the men of Team France donned a redesigned version of the Shadow runner in navy.

Berluti was named the official outfitter of Team France in November of last year (see story).

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
